The design of the seat could differ quite significantly so as to accommodate various requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an example, designs could be decorated with drilled openings, could include gaps or low backs for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back may be designed as an included headrest by way of extending the height above the occupant's head. Seats can be constructed together with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool that is designed to be utilized as a movable footrest.
